

RESOLUTION NO. 799

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY'S ACCEPTANCE
OF THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT STIMULUS
FUNDS FOR EAST GROVER STREET PROJECT NO. 2008-05**

WHEREAS, the City has received stimulus funds through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) through the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) in the amount of \$1,309,000 for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City will be utilizing water and sewer utility funds (in proportion to project costs for these components), as well as \$1.34 million dollars from the arterial street fund, to complete the estimated \$3.7-\$4.0 million project; and

WHEREAS, the WSDOT requires confirmation from the Lynden City Council that this local fund match will be available and will be used for this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lynden City Council of the City of Lynden, Washington, as follows:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Lynden, Washington, hereby confirms that local funds will be provided to supplement the \$1,309,000 ARRA stimulus funding for the East Grover Street Project No. 2008-05 through approval of this Resolution No. 799.

Section 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

Section 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect on March 16, 2009.
