

**RESOLUTION NO. 802**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 789 REGARDING WATER  
GENERAL FACILITIES CHARGES  
FOR THE CITY OF LYNDEN, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Lynden, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

**Section 1:** Section 1 of Resolution No. 789 is amended to read as follows:

General Facilities Charges {Water}  
(New Services)

Meter Size	Charge
3/4-inch	\$ 3,638
1-inch	\$ 6,064
1-1/2-inch	\$ 12,128
2-inch	\$ 19,405
3-inch	\$ 38,811
4-inch	\$ 60,641
6-inch	\$ 121,284
8-inch	\$ 194,054
10-inch	\$ 278,952

**Section 2:** Following, is additional rate classification information:

- A. When a service is changed from a smaller meter to a larger meter, the fee calculation shall be the difference between the two.
- B. When a service is changed from a larger meter to a smaller meter, there will be no fee credit adjustment.

**Section 3:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions to conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

**Section 4:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases have been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason this Resolution should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

**Section 5:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on May 1, 2009.
