

RESOLUTION NO. 797

A RESOLUTION REGARDING STORM WATER MANAGEMENT
GENERAL FACILITY IMPROVEMENT CHARGES FOR THE CITY OF
LYNDEN, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lynden, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

The Storm Water Management General Facility Improvement Charges shall be as follows:

Customer Category	FCI Fee	Increment over 10,000 SF
Single Family and/or Multi-Family Dwelling Unit with Individual Meter (Including Duplex)	\$240/unit	
Non-Single Family (up to 10,000 sf)	\$480	Additional \$240 for each 5,000 sf over 10,000 sf
Non-Single Family w/ Water Quality Treatment	\$480	Additional \$180 for each 5,000 sf over 10,000 sf
Non-Single Family w/ Detention and Water Quality Treatment (up to 10,000 sf)	\$480	Additional \$120 for each 5,000 sf over 10,000 sf
Non-Single Family w/ Retention and Water Quality Treatment (up to 10,000 sf)	\$480	Additional \$60 for each 5,000 sf over 10,000 sf

Section 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, or unconstitutional, then the original Resolution or Resolutions shall be in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect 27 days from the date hereof.


